
• Our Rental and Lease agreements range from one day to three years.

Owning trucks is getting more and more expensive... Literally.

• Half ton pick-ups have outpaced inflation by about 3 percentage points since 2008.



Average Price Increase per truck: 50.21% (4.56% annualized) Inflation Rate for the same period: 16.69% (1.52% annualized)

• The initial capital cost, financing (interest), depreciation, property tax, insurance, fuel, licensing/titling, maintenance, repairs, and admin labor all must be accounted for.



Leasing is an ideal way to do this since shorter terms are common and mitigate the risks and maintenance costs associated with owning older trucks." - Mathew Wiethoff

• Mike Spence, senior vice president of fleet services at Fleet Advantage, said maintenance costs for vehicles aged 4-6 years are nearly 3 times higher than they are in years 1-3.


